Question 1 - Section 9 - Criteria for Award: The section does not specify the Technical and Financial Weights (e.g. 70/30) that will be used to perform the evaluation. Can you please provide these weights.

The (BPQR) is established by weighing technical quality against price on a 70/30 basis respectively. This will be done by multiplying:

- The technical scores awarded to the offers by 0.70
- The financial scores awarded to the offers by 0.30

Question 2 - Section 9.3 Evaluation Grid: The marks for Strategy sub-criterion B, sum up to 14, instead of 20 marks. Can you please provide a corrected table.

Amended as follows:

Sub-criterion B: (mandatory)

A descriptive report (of approximately 500 words) identifying the major milestones to be achieved in the execution of this contract and a description of the approach proposed to undertake the 8 activities (1.1 – 1.8) by the Contractor in connection to the achievement of the contract objectives, as per Terms of Reference Article 2

The identification of the major milestones for Activities 1.1 - 1.8 will be given as follows:

- Activity 1.1 The general methodology proposed based on the literature review carried out (1 mark)
- Activity 1.2 Baseline & Gap Analysis (3 marks)
- Activity 1.3 -Trend Forecasting (3 marks)
- Activity 1.4 Impact & Constraints Mapping (3 marks)
- Activity 1.5 Identify the implications arising from Spatial limitations and the host community/residents' tolerance level (3 marks)
- Activity 1.6 Destinations, Attractions & Tourism Asset Eco-system Mapping (3 marks)
- Activity 1.7 Trends & Opportunities (3 marks)
- Activity 1.8 Recommendations & Validation of Conclusions (1 mark)

Maximum 20 marks

1 mark will be allocated to Activity 1.1 and Activity 1.8 whereas the remaining points will be divided equally (i.e 3 marks for each activity) among activities 1.2-1.7 mentioned in Section 4.2 of the Terms of Reference.

Question 3 - Section 9.3 Evaluation Grid: Strategy sub-criterion C: Do Economists qualify as Key Experts?
